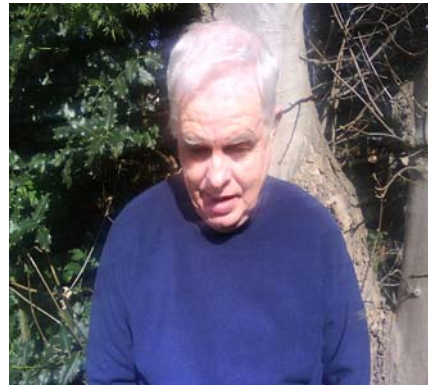
About the Home

67 Boroughbridge road is a two storey end of terrace house, managed by St Anne's Community Services. The home is situated on a main road in the market town of Knaresborough . Local facilities include a large variety of shops and a post office which is nearby. The home provides residential care to three adults with learning disabilities. All the bedrooms provide single accommodation one of which has en suite facilities. The house communal area's compromise of a kitchen, dining room and two lounge area's. Well maintained garden's can be seen to the front and back of the property.

We support people to maintain their independence by providing excellent staffing 24 hours a day throughout the year.

Each client has a individual care plan which puts the person at the centre of their own care planning process.

Regular monitoring of the plan ensures that agreed goals are being achieved. Regular reviews also ensure that as people's needs change, the service responds in a flexible and sensitive way. All care plans help to support individuals to exercise choice and make decisions affecting their lives
