Caring in the Community

St. Anne's is one of the major non-statutory providers of community care in Yorkshire, with projects in North and South Yorkshire, Leeds, Kirklees, Calderdale and the North East. All these services have been developed in partnership with Health and Local Authorities and, in the case of Benedicts, the Leeds Joint Commissioning Service.

Since its foundation in 1971, St. Anne's has earned a reputation for providing innovative ways of responding to individual needs with high quality services. It provides a wide range of housing, day care and support to homeless people and people with special needs, including those with learning disability, mental ill-health or substance misuse problems.

Our residential services are geared to the needs of individual residents and aim to produce independence, skills and abilities; to enable people to have as much choice as possible in their own lives and to provide appropriate levels of care and support.

Our aim is to provide:-

Accommodation that is a home, rather than simply a house, by creating a supportive and secure environment, but one which respects personal privacy and dignity and which also offers social and emotional support.

Clients are encouraged to take as much responsibility for themselves as they can, and to take advantage of all local leisure, educational and employment opportunities.

Clients are fully involved in the development of their care plans and the regular review of their needs. They are encouraged and supported in making informed choices about their lives and in taking responsibility for the consequences of their decisions.

Even after leaving St. Anne's, former clients continue to be offered support and friendship.

Learning Disability Services in Leeds

Benedicts, Wetherby

Benedicts is a 20-bedded Nursing Home with special provision for people with a learning disability whose overriding need is for specialist health care intervention.

Nursing staff trained in either learning disabilities or general nursing are supported by a team of carers providing a high standard of holistic care 24 hours per day.

Special adaptations provided for the less physically able include disabled toilets, ceiling track hoists, Arjo and Parker baths, ramps and handrails.

We have our own adapted minibus which enables our clients to access the facilities in the community and pursue interests such as college, hydrotherapy, outings and holidays.

In house, we offer a leisure and recreation programme, aromatherapy, reflexology, chiropody, hairdressing and a Snoezelen environment.

Clients access the services of local GPs and we liaise effectively with other health professionals, such as the Community Physiotherapist, Dietician and Occupational Therapist.
