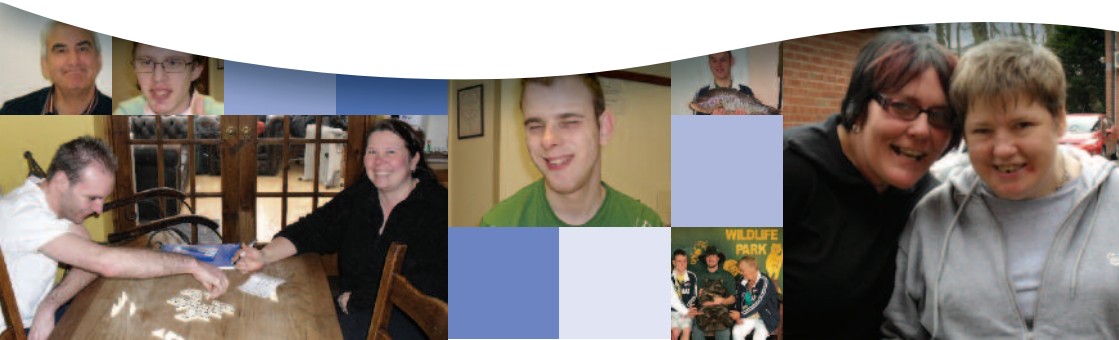
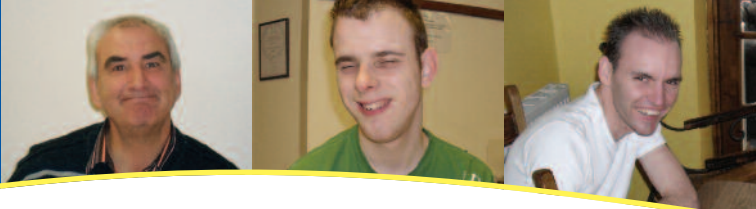

Offering Homes to People with Learning Disabilities





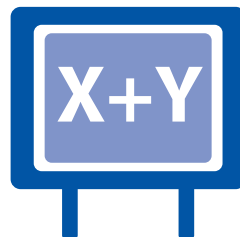
What is Shared Lives?

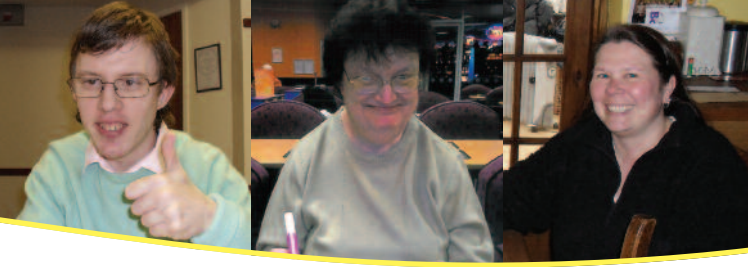
St. Anne's Shared Lives find people who live in their own houses, who want to offer a home to a person with learning disabilities.

This used to be called 'adult placement' and is now called 'Shared Lives'.



These people are trained and assessed and if they are suitable, they can become carers.





Carers live in a range of houses in different parts of the Leeds area.



The scheme is registered with the Care Quality Commission. Their last inspection report said the scheme was 'excellent'.

You can see it if you wish.





Carers

Carers will offer you a home with them for as long as you need or want it.

They will:

Give you your own room.

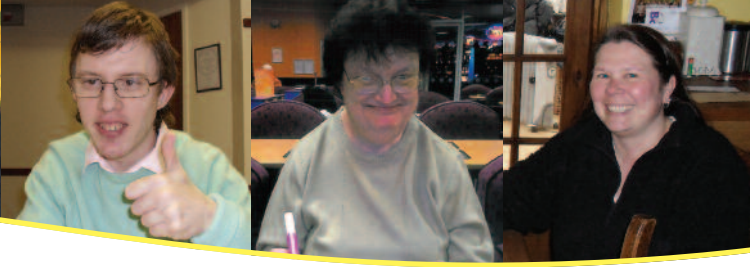


Provide all your meals.



Give you whatever help you may need





Support you in becoming as independent as possible.



Support you in keeping contact with your own friends and family.



Help you learn new things and develop your skills





Making an Application

When you apply we will:

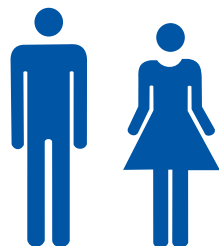
Meet with you to talk about what it is like to live with a carer.

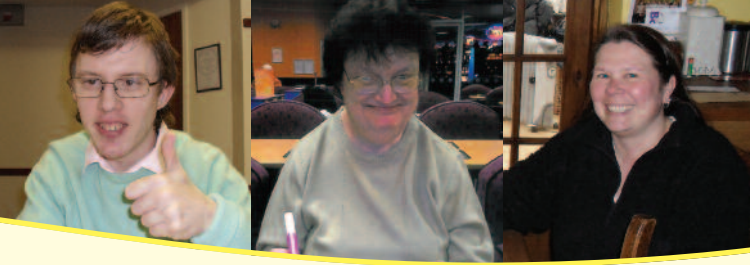
Ask you, and people who know you, questions to help us find the right carers for you.

Look for carers for you. (This may take a long time as it is important to get the right carers for you).

Arrange for you to meet with carers to help you decide if you would like to live with them. This will include overnight stays and an introductory period of three months.

Once you have moved in, we will visit you and your carer regularly to make sure you are getting the care and support you need.
