Cloughside is situated in the village of Walsden on the outskirts of Todmorden, West Yorkshire and provides support for people with a learning disability who challenge.

As a registered nursing home we have around the clock qualified R.N.L.D. nurse cover and are intensively staffed to meet the diverse needs of clients.

Each client is allocated a qualified "named nurse" who is responsible for assessment of needs. This assessment considers general needs and specific support around behaviours. Planning and implementation of support is through person centred approaches. The effectiveness of agreed strategies and protocols is continually evaluated through multi and inter agency working with other colleagues, professionals and

Choice

Strategies for managing behaviour are developed and undertaken with reference to the Lavigna-Willis "Multi-Element Model" which advocates a holistic approach to understanding the needs of an Individual who displays behaviour that may challenge. By initiating "behaviour supports" behaviour is managed 80% pro-actively by, e.g. adaptations to the environment , skills teaching and focussed support .

Any identified health needs resulting from the ageing process or physical illness are respected and considered on an individualised basis.

The home has two people carriers which allow clients to access the wider community whilst excellent local public transport links also facilitate community participation and presence.
