Choice and Opportunity

St. Anne's has more than 25 years' experience of providing community based mental health services in Leeds.

We offer 49 single tenancies within a range of shared supported accommodation. We accommodate people who have serious and enduring mental health problems and who are either homeless or unsuitably housed.

Our aim is to create a secure environment which respects personal privacy and promotes recovery, independence, abilities.

Tenants are fully involved in the development of their individual Support Plan and are supported to take up leisure, educational and employment opportunities.

We work closely with both statutory and voluntary sector agencies to provide integrated support to individual tenants. Tenants have diverse backgrounds and needs; our aim is to work as flexibly as possible to meet these.

Referrals and Assessment

We accept referrals from any source, including self-referrals. Applications will be made through the St. Anne's application form and a detailed assessment will be undertaken with the applicant.

Tenant Participation

St. Anne's promotes Client involvement throughout the organisation. Tenants are encouraged to be as involved as possible in the running of the service. This may be through one to one discussion or through regular house meetings.

Tenants are offered involvement in recruitment and staff selection.

Satisfaction surveys are Undertaken annually, providing tenants with the opportunity to comment on all aspects of the support and housing services offered.

Shared Supported Housing

There are five shared houses, with varying levels of support.

- Three houses provide 24 hour support, with sleep-in staff, to a total of 35 people. The houses are in the Beeston and Headingley areas. Meals are provided, with tenants encouraged to have as much choice and involvement as possible.
 - Another house is in the Headingley area and provides accommodation for 7 people. Staff support is available in the house during the week, including evenings and for part of the weekend. Some meals are provided. An out of hours advice line is available to tenants.
- A house in the Harehills area provides housing with support for a further
- 7 people. Staff support is available during the day from Monday to Friday.
 - Tenants are fully self catering. An out of hours advice line is available.
