## WHAT IS HOLDFORTH COURT?

Holdforth Court is a 36-bed hostel in the centre of Leeds for single homeless men over 16 years of age.

Holdforth Court is purpose built accommodation that provides high quality single room accommodation.

The Hostel also provides, 24 hour staffing, a safe environment in secure premises, and the opportunity to break free from the homeless lifestyle.

### **St Anne's Community Services**

St. Anne's was established from a commitment to social justice and a determination to make real changes to the lives of homeless people. Today, these ideals remain as strong as ever. St Anne's is now a major provider of support and care services in Yorkshire & the Humber and the North East.

The wide range of provision includes supported housing and supported living, residential care, community based services and Adult Placement. As well as working with homeless people St Anne's also supports people with substance use issues, people with mental health difficulties and people with a learning disability.

Services for homeless people are currently located in Leeds, Sheffield and Dewsbury.

Working in partnership with Local Authorities and Health services, St. Anne's has rightly earned a reputation for providing innovative ways of responding to individual needs with high quality services.

## SERVICES PROVIDED

### Services

- ◇ 24 hour staffing
- ◇ Dedicated key worker,
- ◇ Resettlement Worker and Independent Living Skills Worker
- ◇ Benefits advice and assistance
- ◇ Access to primary health care
- ◇ Structured resettlement plans with move-on accommodation
- ◇ Drug and alcohol advice and referral.
- ◇ Move on accommodation

### Facilities

- ◇ Single rooms
- ◇ Laundry facilities
- ◇ Residents have access to 3 kitchens to make their own food. There are also 2 training kitchens

### Referrals and Assessment

The aim of Holdforth Court is to look at the immediate and future needs of single homeless men.

Referrals to the hostel can be made through either the Leeds City Council's Housing Options team or Ladybeck Hostel or Pennington Hostel. Following an Initial Needs Assessment, the client will be expected to work with us towards moving on into accommodation suitable for their needs. The key worker, Resettlement Worker and Independent Living Skills Worker will work with the client on a structured resettlement support plan.
