About the Home

The building is a purpose built six/seven bed roomed bungalow with bathroom, shower room, kitchen, lounge / diner, conservatory, and a large garden with a car park, situated about one mile from the centre of Ingleton, which is on the main route to the Lake District.

Lancaster/ Morecambe is situated approximately 16 miles away to the southwest, Settle is 10 miles, and Skipton is 30 miles to the east.

We support people to maintain their independence by providing excellent staffing 24 hours a day throughout the year.

Jenkin Lodge staff team uses person centred approaches to enable the people living in the house to maximise their independence, increase control over their lives, maintain their health and become part of their community.



The support team ensures that Jenkin Lodge continues to be a pleasant comfortable home which seeks to meet the physical , emotional and spiritual needs of each person living in the house.

St Anne's annually seeks feedback from stakeholders and this feedback is considered and acted upon.
