Introducing St Anne's

St Anne's Community Services is an established social care and supported housing organisation working across the north of England.

St Anne's provides a wide range of housing, day care and community support to people with a wide variety of needs. This includes people with a learning disability, a mental health or substance use problem and the many homeless people who still need our services.

St Anne's has rightly earned a reputation for innovation and responding to the needs of individuals with a range of high quality services, working in partnership with health and local authorities and other voluntary organisations.

St Anne's is now a major provider of care and support services throughout Yorkshire and in the North-East.

About Queensway

46 Queensway is home to 6 people with varying degrees of learning disabilities. Some of the people may challenge the service.

People living at Queensway are supported by a staff team made up of nurses and support assistants who provide 24 hour care.

Each person living at Queensway is assigned a named nurse and key worker who co-ordinate their care and help people achieve their goals.

All the people at Queensway have access to all community services and support from the CTLD (Community Learning Disabilities Team).

To access the service you will need to complete a St Anne's application form for services. You will also need to be assessed as requiring a nursing service and be referred by the Community Team for Learning Disabilities (CTLD).

Individual Care

This is monitored through person centred planning which identifies a persons needs, choices and independence .

All aspects of care, leisure and everyday living is discussed with people living in the home.

Different methods of communication systems are promoted and reflect individual needs.

All staff at Queensway strive to provide support in all aspects of peoples lives encouraging choice, independence and new opportunities.

Leisure

All people living at Queensway are supported and encouraged to access leisure/social activities and hobbies.
