We adopt a person centred approach and pride ourselves on a multi agency working.

Support packages are devised by the client, Care Co-ordinator and the people who are important to them and who know them best. Support will be reviewed on a regular basis to ensure that is still relevant and is meeting the persons needs. The Supported Living team will provide advice and practical support around budgeting, daily living skills, health issues, social interactions & any other areas identified by the people we support that will promote their independence, opportunity and inclusion.

This will enable us to decide the appropriateness of the service and agree support needs and funding. A decision will be made by the referral panel and all applicants and referrers (where permission is given) will be informed of the outcome in writing. There is a right of appeal regarding any decision and this will be clearly explained at the time of referral.

Domiciliary Care – What does this mean?

The service is in the process of being registered with Care Quality Commission as a Domiciliary Care Service. This means we will be inspected on a regular basis, to ensure a high level of support is provided.
