What the service provides

The Team

The Team has four Resettlement Workers.

Three Resettlement Workers are based in the City Centre of Sheffield. The fourth Resettlement Worker is based at Bevin Court Hostel in Woodhouse and supports clients moving out of the Hostel into their own tenancies.

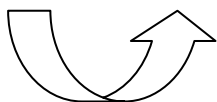
How we will work with you

We will work in an empowering manner to assist you live as independently as possible.

- We will ask you questions about your needs and fill out forms to assess how we can assist you.
- You will meet with a worker who will agree a plan of support.
- Meetings can take place in your own home, or at an agreed place.
- Your support will be reviewed on a regular basis.

How can we help you

- Ensure that full benefits are claimed.
- Help to get furniture.
- Ensure that gas, electric and water is connected.
- Budgeting advice.
- Help with accessing local services such as doctor and dentist.
- Advice/help with cooking, cleaning and shopping.
- Listening and advocacy.
- Help in getting to know the community.
- Assistance with finding training, education and employment.
- Signposting to relevant specialist agencies.

- Males and females over sixteen years of age.
- People in interim accommodation or in their own tenancies.
