About Fernlea

Fernlea was established in 1998 and is a registered Nursing Home for people with Learning Disabilities. The Care Quality Commission has assessed Fernlea as providing 2 star good quality outcomes. We are continuing to build upon our success by promoting choice, rights, dignity and respect on a person centred approach for long term clients aged between 18 and 65 years of age promoting equality and diversity. Staff working in the home ensure that clients are always at the centre of everything that we do. The house has been purpose built on one level to enable access to all areas for clients.

Fernlea is a 2 sided integrated bungalow supporting those who challenge the service and those with complex health needs. Each side has 3 to 4 bedrooms, fitted with a variety of adaptations to meet peoples support needs including tracking aid and hoists. Each side also has a shower room, bathroom, kitchen, living area, and garden space. Each resident has their individual bedroom decorated to their own individual tastes. 2 bedrooms in the part of the service for people with complex health needs have

direct access from their bedroom to the bathroom.

The staff team consists of nursing and support assistants providing 24 hour support. Each client has their own primary nurse and key worker who co-ordinate their care. Clients have access to community services and the service works with a variety of agencies to promote a multi disciplinary and holistic approach to care.

The home also has access to 2 vehicles which are adapted to ensure all clients can access community facilities.
