About the Home

Lees Hall Road is a Registered Residential care home which provides 24 hour support for 8 adults 18-65 years old who have mild/moderate learning disabilities and have either offended or have the potential to offend.

The purpose of the home is to support individuals for a maximum of 2 years. During this time there is an ongoing multi-disciplinary assessment process that identified and manages risks while enabling individuals to access community facilities, develop their independent skills eg cooking, shopping, cleaning, manage their finances and enable them to enjoy a good quality of life.

There are a minimum of 2 staff on duty at all times this includes a member of staff sleeping in and a waking night. The staff team are well trained, competent and supportive.

Our service provides an excellent standard of care, healthcare, appropriate opportunities for social relationships, education and training, leisure, employment and spiritual fulfilment.

We work alongside other agencies towards moving people on to appropriate alternative accommodation that meets their long term needs.
