Introducing St Anne's

St Anne's Community Services is an established social care and supported housing organisation working across the north of England.

St Anne's provides a wide range of housing, day care and community support to people with a learning disability, a mental health or substance use problem and the many homeless people who still need our services.

St Anne's has rightly earned a reputation for innovation and responding to the needs of individuals with a range of high quality service, working in partnership with health and local authorities and other voluntary organisations.

St Anne's is now a major provider of care and support services throughout Yorkshire and in North-East.

Calderdale Residential Care Homes

St Anne's residential care service in Calderdale consists of two homes. Hawthorn Street in Hipperholme is a semi-detached house and is set over two floors that can accommodate up to seven residents with learning disabilities supported by a well trained and established staff team.

Sutherland Court is a purpose built bungalow at Lightcliffe, its design lends itself to meet the needs of people with physical and sensory disabilities as well as a learning disability and those with more complex health needs or degenerative conditions.

Both properties are situated in Halifax in well served communities, with shops, cafes, library and leisure facilities all close by. The homes are within easy travelling distance of Leeds, Bradford, Huddersfield and the M62 motorway links. Referrals to the service are accepted from health and social care professionals; we are always pleased to have the opportunity to discuss how our service can meet the needs of adults with a learning disability.
