Our Services

We are proud to deliver four respite services and nurse led respite services across West Yorkshire.

Foxview - Dewsbury

In the lovely ground of Dewsbury Hospital, Foxview provides crisis respite care for adults with a learning disability and additional complex needs, including mental health, autism and nursing care. The service provides four respite beds and two emergency support beds.

Foxview is fully accessible and benefits from a large garden. The team at Foxview promotes promotes community participation and leisure activities. Guests also continue to access day centres during the day and other community-based activities they would usually do when at home.



Shady Trees, Huddersfield

Shady Trees offers a nursing respite service for up to 25 adults aged 18 and over who have learning disabilities and other complex physical health needs.

The home is registered to provide accommodation for people who require personal or nursing care. Up to four people can be accommodated at any one time.



Foxview, Dewsbury

Our Services

Westgarth, Halifax

Westgarth provides safe and comfortable accommodation for adults with learning disabilities, giving them and their carers a welcome break.

A new facility, it has been planned with its users' needs fully in mind with fully accessible accommodation and bathroom facilities, finished to a high standard.

The building also includes a number of self-contained living units to support people to maintain their independence and further develop the skills they need to lead full and active lives.

Aachen Brook, Halifax

Aachen Brook supports up to five adults with learning disabilities, physical disabilities, and Mental health needs.

A fully wheelchair-accessible bungalow, there are five ensuite rooms which all have overhead tracing, TV's, sensory equipment, and profiling beds. Bedroom furniture can be customised to client taste for a homely feel. Aachen Brook has an accessible bathroom with a parker bath and accessible shower.

Providing a lovely communal area, the service has a large dinning kitchen area with lowering tables, and work units. The service also has a spacious garden with decking area, and a courtyard with a water feature.





Whiteoak, Bradford

Whiteoak is a specialist residential service for people with learning disabilities and autism who require a short break with specialised support facilities.

The service is divided into three suites enabling the service to support people with different needs. The services have spacious living areas, adapted showers and bathrooms, a multi-sensory room and private, accessible gardens.

Assisted technology is installed according to individual needs, and everyone is encouraged to truly personalise their own bedroom.

Each of our respite services has a highly trained and qualified multi-disciplinary team, who are experts in understanding and using Person Centred care approaches and planning.
